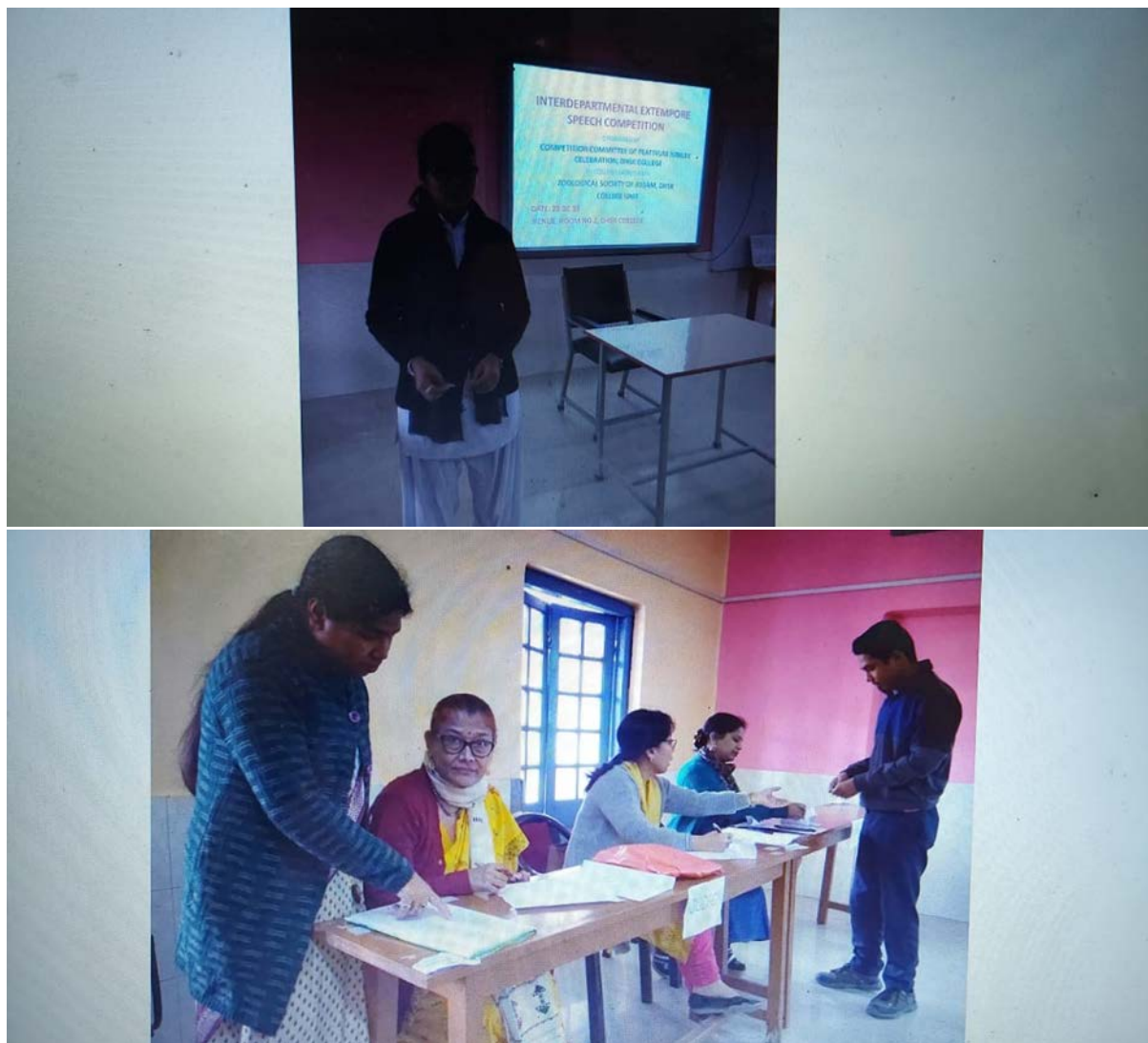
2) Inter departmental extempore speech competition

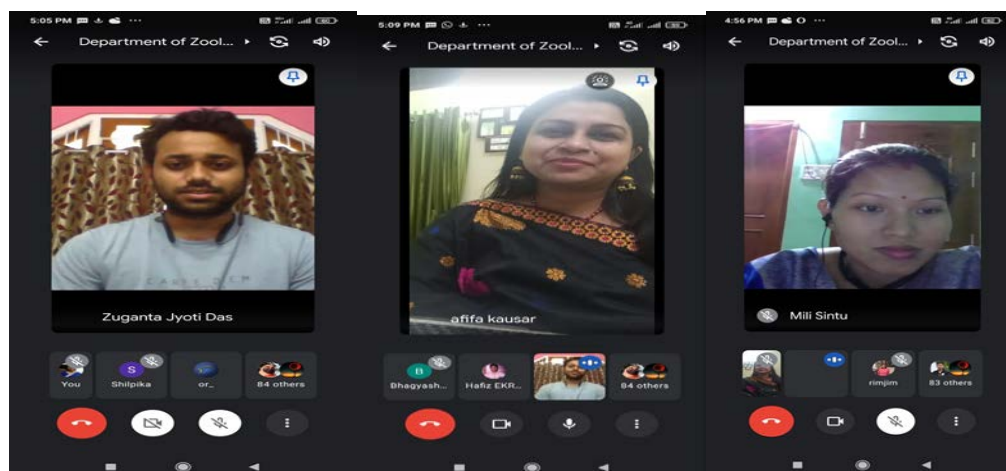
